

MADISON COUNTY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP

OBJECTIVE

To provide scholarships to Madison County Farm Bureau members, spouses, or their dependents who major in agriculture, agribusiness, or an ag-related course of study. These scholarships are awarded only to students who attend schools located in Illinois and are based on scholastic ability. The Madison County Farm Bureau Scholarship is intended to financially assist a well-qualified and professional within Illinois agriculture.

ELIGIBILITY

Must be a high school graduate that has applied, intends to apply, or has been accepted for enrollment at an accredited Illinois college, university, or community college.

OR

Must be a Madison County Farm Bureau member, spouse of member, or dependent of a member that is enrolled in an accredited Illinois college, university, or community college.

2022 recipients are not eligible for award.

SCHOLARSHIP(S) AVAILABLE - \$500.00 per semester, \$1,000.00 total.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

In addition to the eligibility guideline, the following will be considered in selecting recipients:

- 1. Academic performance
 - * Honors
 - * Test scores
 - * GPA
- 2. Demonstrated interest in agriculture and/or agribusiness
 - * Organization involvement
 - * Employment
 - * Professional goals
 - * Course work
- 3. Evidence of self-help (How the student is contributing financially to his/her education)
- 4. Professional goals
 - * Industriousness and motivation
 - * Intellectual interest

TERMS

All scholarship funds will be sent to the university, college, or community college prior to the beginning of each semester. This will be done after Madison County Farm Bureau receives proof of enrollment. The institution will apply these funds toward the student's tuition and/or room and board. Scholarship recipients are not restricted from pursuing and accepting other forms of financial aid, assistantship, or tuition waiver.
